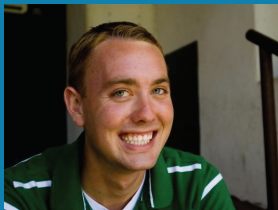




prayer requests

One of the amazing aspects of Campus Crusade is their focus on the training of the staff. A few weeks ago, I arrived in Fort Collins, Colorado for a summer of training. I quickly learned how much I was in for though. Professors from some of the top seminaries in the nation, including Dallas Theological Seminary, started arriving shortly after I did to teach seminary classes for 600+ staff members. For a two week period, I slaved over four hours of class and seven hours of homework every day. The work was worth it though. I completed and got graduate seminary credit for classes in Bible Study Methods and Introduction to Christian Theology. I am preparing to start New Testament Survey and soon I'll be three classes closer to a seminary degree!

This summer has also expanded my knowledge of what God is doing worldwide. As I sat with Vonette Bright, the co-founder of Campus Crusade along with her late husband, Bill Bright, I heard an amazing recount of what God has done through Campus Crusade over the last sixty years. In starting on a single campus in 1951, the Brights literally signed a contract with God to use them however He pleased. Sixty years later, Campus Crusade is the largest Christian missions organization in the world with 27,000 full-time missionaries, hundreds of thousands of volunteers, and an ability to send to any country in the world. What God has done is incredible!

In the next few weeks, I will be joined here at Colorado State University by over 5,000 staff

from around the country. We will be spending over a week hearing from speakers such as Francis Chan and David Platt and doing worship with the David Crowder Band! It's a time for all of the staff here in the United States to relax, grow in their faith, and be encouraged to keep striving after the goal of completing the Great Commission in our generation! I'm really looking forward to the this conference.

In a few weeks, I will be leaving Colorado and heading back to Merced where I will once again be looking to develop a team of ministry partners who will respond in prayer and financial giving. As I am stepping out and trusting God with an indefinite time in full-time ministry, so I am asking my partners to do the same in prayer and finances. I know that God will provide and I trust Him completely to bring in everything that I need. Please be in prayer for me as I begin this process.
